Second Supplier Survey

Kyokuyo Co., Ltd. conducted its second Supplier Survey to promote responsible procurement throughout the supply chain, expanding the scope to include overseas suppliers of Kyokuyo Co., Ltd. and supplier of its group companies.

1. Survey Overview

Scope: Domestic and overseas suppliers of Kyokuyo Co., Ltd. and its group companies

Period: June to September 2024

Method: Online questionnaire survey

2. Survey Items

- (1) Efforts to prevent human rights violations (measures against forced labor and child labor, prevention of discrimination, etc.)
- (2) Measures against climate change (initiatives to reduce greenhouse gas emissions, calculation of emissions, etc.)
- (3) Promotion of responsible procurement (measures against IUU fishing, etc.)

3. Number of responses to the survey

217 companies (accounting for approximately 81% of the Kyokuyo Group's total domestic purchase value in FY2023)

Survey targets: 257 companies (representing an 84% response rate)

4. Response measures

We provide individual feedback to the suppliers who responded to the survey, using tools such as radar charts to compare their initiatives with the average of all responding companies. Based on the survey results, suppliers whose initiatives are deemed insufficient are asked to consider future actions at the time of feedback. We will continue to conduct surveys to monitor their progress. Even for suppliers whose efforts are currently considered sufficient, we will carry out regular surveys to identify and mitigate risks within the supply chain.
